



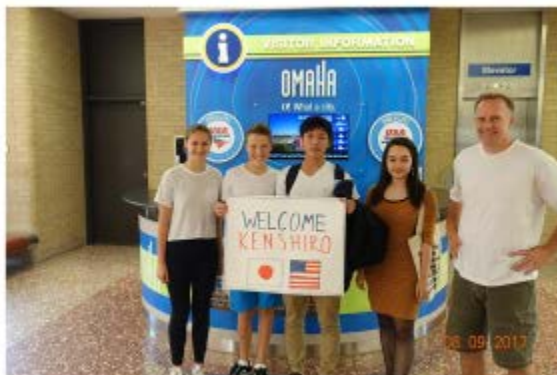
This Week at Rotary #14: August 22
