US Department of State International Visitor Program - "#HiddenNoMore: Empowering Women in STEM" Panel

Throughout 2017, U.S. Embassies and Consulates in over 80 countries have screened the movie *Hidden Figures*, generating discussions on race equality, gender equality and women in STEM careers. In the wae of these successful screenings,Â *Hidden Figures*Â has inspired the U.S. Department of State's International Visitor Leadership Program (IVLP) to launch a professional exchange program called "Hidden No More: Empowering Women Leaders in STEM."Â
