## TUESDAY, JUNE 2 — PHIL TEGELER, THE BRIDGE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH

Phil Tegeler is the Executive Director of The Bridge Behavioral Health, a substance use treatment center located in Lincoln for more than 30 years. Phil leads a staff of 50 associates, as they guide people through safe passage from addiction to sober living.

As a key part of Lincoln's community safety net, The Bridge Behavioral Health is responding to recent trends regarding alcohol and drug use in our community. Phil's presentation, entitled "Substance Use Trends in Our Community" will update us on those trends including use of synthetic drugs and binge drinking by minors, and outline The Bridge's response to those trends.

Phil is involved, personally and professionally, in a variety of efforts regarding identification of substance use issues in the community and providing timely, effective responses to those issues. His background includes experience in the development and management of employee assistance programs serving both public and private sector employers across Nebraska. Additionally, Phil served 10 years as Senior Director, Global Marketing for MDS Pharma Services.
